

#### Reading of the holy gospel according to saint John (1:35-42)

John was standing with two of his disciples, and as he watched Jesus walk by, he said, "Behold, the Lamb of God." The two disciples heard what he said and followed Jesus. Jesus turned and saw them following him and said to them, "What are you looking for?" They said to him, "Rabbi" — which translated means Teacher —, "where are you staying?" He said to them, "Come, and you will see." So they went and saw where Jesus was staying, and they stayed with him that day. It was about four in the afternoon. Andrew, the brother of Simon Peter, was one of the two who heard John and followed Jesus. He first found his own brother Simon and told him, "We have found the Messiah" — which is translated Christ —. Then he brought him to Jesus. Jesus looked at him and said, "You are Simon the son of John; you will be called Cephas" — which is translated Peter.

The gospel tells us about vocation. A kind of vocation that knows how to sacrifice and love for his brethren. In our context, loving someone propels us to know more the person's identity and so with us in our relationship with the Lord. As we get to know him our hearts are ignited by his love which burst forth to others. How do I sustain my intimacy with the Lord? What are my concrete ways?
