

# APRIL 14, 2024 GOSPEL

#### Reading of the Holy Gospel according to Saint Luke (24, 35:48)

The two disciples recounted what had taken place on the way, and how Jesus was made known to them in the breaking of bread.

While they were still speaking about this, he stood in their midst and said to them, "Peace be with you." But they were startled and terrified and thought that they were seeing a ghost. Then he said to them, "Why are you troubled? And why do questions arise in your hearts? Look at my hands and my feet, that it is I myself. Touch me and see, because a ghost does not have flesh and bones as you can see I have." And as he said this, he showed them his hands and his feet. While they were still incredulous for joy and were amazed, he asked them, "Have you anything here to eat?" They gave him a piece of baked fish; he took it and ate it in front of them.

He said to them, "These are my words that I spoke to you while I was still with you, that everything written about me in the law of Moses and in the prophets and psalms must be fulfilled." Then he opened their minds to understand the Scriptures. And he said to them, "Thus it is written that the Christ would suffer and rise from the dead on the third day and that repentance, for the forgiveness of sins, would be preached in his name to all the nations, beginning from Jerusalem. You are witnesses of these things."

# APRIL 14, 2024 REFLECTION

On Easter afternoon, Jesus opens the minds of the disciples to the mystery of his death and resurrection and tells them: "You are witnesses of all this." The Apostles, who saw the risen Christ with their own eyes, could not remain silent about their extraordinary experience. He had shown himself to them so that the truth of his resurrection could reach everyone through his testimony. And the Church has the task of prolonging this mission over time; Each baptized person is called to bear witness, with words and with life, that Jesus has risen, that Jesus is alive and present among us. All of us are called to bear witness that Jesus is alive.

We can ask ourselves: but who is the witness? The witness is one who has seen, who remembers and tells. See, remember and tell are the three verbs that describe identity and mission. The witness is one who has seen, with an objective eye, he has seen a reality, but not with an indifferent eye; He has seen and let himself be involved in the event. That is why he remembers, not only because he knows how to accurately reconstruct the events that happened, but also because those events have spoken to him and he has grasped their deep meaning. Then the witness tells, not in a cold and distant way but as one who has allowed himself to be questioned and since that day has changed his life. The witness is one who has changed his life.

We are witnesses of Jesus Christ when our way of living reflects His teachings. The way we act, speak, dress, and even think should reflect Him and His way of doing things. We are witnesses of Jesus Christ when we talk to others about the feelings we have about Him. We are witnesses of Jesus Christ when we have a happy outlook that reflects our faith in Him. We are witnesses of Jesus Christ when we tell others our testimony and help them learn of Him and to follow Him.
