### JUNE 30, 2024 GOSPEL

#### Reading of the Holy Gospel according to Saint Mark (5, 21-24. 35-43)

When Jesus had crossed again in the boat to the other side, a large crowd gathered around him, and he stayed close to the sea. One of the synagogue officials, named Jairus, came forward. Seeing him he fell at his feet and pleaded earnestly with him, saying, "My daughter is at the point of death. Please, come lay your hands on her that she may get well and live." He went off with him, and a large crowd followed him and pressed upon him.

While he was still speaking, people from the synagogue official's house arrived and said, "Your daughter has died; why trouble the teacher any longer?" Disregarding the message that was reported, Jesus said to the synagogue official, "Do not be afraid; just have faith." He did not allow anyone to accompany him inside except Peter, James, and John, the brother of James. When they arrived at the house of the synagogue official, he caught sight of a commotion, people weeping and wailing loudly. So he went in and said to them, "Why this commotion and weeping? The child is not dead but asleep." And they ridiculed him. Then he put them all out. He took along the child's father and mother and those who were with him and entered the room where the child was. He took the child by the hand and said to her, "Talitha koum," which means, "Little girl, I say to you, arise!"The girl, a child of twelve, arose immediately and walked around. At that they were utterly astounded. He gave strict orders that no one should know this and said that she should be given something to eat.

### JUNE 30, 2024 REFLECTION

The narrative returns to the journey to Jairus' house. The delay — to "heal" and "converse" with the unnamed woman — led to a report from Jairus' household that his daughter had already died. Despite the way circumstances looked, there was a firm belief in the sovereignty of God.

Jesus challenged Jairus to hold on to his faith (i.e., "only believe"), a faith that led him to the healer in the first place. Jesus, also, took further action. He reduced the number of potential witnesses to three – Peter, James, and John – an inner group who would also receive other special revelations at the transfiguration and in Gethsemane. This reduction of witnesses would continue after the tear-wearied circle at Jairus' home ridiculed Jesus' assessment of the situation.

The episode of Christ restoring a twelve year old girl to life is retold in three of the gospels. This 12-year old daughter of Jairus, a number that reminded readers of the earlier "daughter" of Jesus.Finally, Jesus wanted "silence" about this healing, like many performed on the Jewish side of the lake. Also, he requested food for the raised girl, suggesting the holistic mission that showed his care for all needs — spiritual, physical, emotional and psychological.

Jesus reminds the church and individual believers to keep their faith in Him. Christ instructed to hold onto the hope of His return, not allowing individual naysayers or the cynical culture to cause the Christians to renounce their reliance on God. The race of faith requires preparation, perseverance and other faithful friends to help us finish well. The victor's crown is not royalty, but a wreath of righteousness given by the Righteous One—Jesus. Yes, when we faithfully hang onto Jesus—we experience joy—in anticipation of His eternal joy unspeakable!
