OCTOBER 6, 2024 GOSPEL

Reading of the Holy Gospel according to Saint Mark (10, 2-16)

The Pharisees approached Jesus and asked, "Is it lawful for a husband to divorce his wife?" They were testing him. He said to them in reply, "What did Moses command you?" They replied, "Moses permitted a husband to write a bill of divorce and dismiss her." But Jesus told them, "Because of the hardness of your hearts he wrote you this commandment. But from the beginning of creation, God made them male and female. For this reason a man shall leave his father and mother and be joined to his wife, and the two shall become one flesh. So they are no longer two but one flesh. Therefore what God has joined together, no human being must separate." In the house the disciples again questioned Jesus about this. He said to them, "Whoever divorces his wife and marries another commits adultery against her; and if she divorces her husband and marries another, she commits adultery."

And people were bringing children to him that he might touch them, but the disciples rebuked them. When Jesus saw this he became indignant and said to them, "Let the children come to me; do not prevent them, for the kingdom of God belongs to such as these. Amen, I say to you, whoever does not accept the kingdom of God like a child will not enter it." Then he embraced them and blessed them, placing his hands on them.

LORD'S WORD



REFLECTION

In this Gospel, Jesus is reminding us this commandment, "That thou shalt not commit adultery." God made male and female for each other. Their vow in front of the altar is a sacred one. Anyone who breaks it commits adultery. The Church teaches that we can only marry once. This teaches faithfulness of the husband and the wife. They are committed for life.

The Gospel is telling us that God is the God of unity. Marriage is the union of two different individuals living and growing in unity-in diversity. Jesus tells that divorce is a compromise resulting from the hardness of the human heart. Jesus pointed out unity in the spirit of authentic love- his sacrifice on the cross. The spirit of faith is a "spirit that allows one to search for God's will in order to carry out his saving plan." We need to redirect the stubbornness of our hearts into a loving hearts and aim towards unity that we yearn for. Let us allow ourselves to be like Jesus ever loving and caring to everyone.

How do we become like children? I think it starts with recognizing that everything we have, and more importantly everything we need, comes from God. As we get older we like to think that we can handle things on our own. We don't like to think of ourselves as being needy, but that is exactly what we must do. Accompanying that understanding is trust. Little children trust that their parents will provide for them. We must place our trust in God that He will provide for our needs. And like little children, who know to turn to their parents for help, we must continually bring our worries, our concerns, and our problems, to our heavenly Father. Finally, we must be obedient, like little children, to God our Father, and His will for our lives.
