# OCTOBER 20, 2024 GOSPEL

#### Reading of the Holy Gospel according to Saint Mark (10, 35-45)

James and John, the sons of Zebedee, came to Jesus and said to him,
"Teacher, we want you to do for us whatever we ask of you." He
replied, "What do you wish me to do for you?" They answered him,
"Grant that in your glory we may sit one at your right and the other at
your left." Jesus said to them, "You do not know what you are asking.
Can you drink the cup that I drink or be baptized with the baptism
with which I am baptized?" They said to him, "We can." Jesus said to
them, "The cup that I drink, you will drink, and with the baptism with
which I am baptized, you will be baptized; but to sit at my right or at
my left is not mine to give but is for those for whom it has been
prepared."

When the ten heard this, they became indignant at James and John. Jesus summoned them and said to them, "You know that those who are recognized as rulers over the Gentiles lord it over them, and their great ones make their authority over them felt. But it shall not be so among you. Rather, whoever wishes to be great among you will be your servant; whoever wishes to be first among you will be the slave of all. For the Son of Man did not come to be served but to serve and to give his life as a ransom for many."

# REFLECTION

The request of the apostles brings to light our natural desires to be approved of and rewarded in worldly terms. Jesus tells us his meaning of real greatness, the service and the care of others. Jesus came not to be served but to serve.

These are the most essential words of a true believer.

A true servant's heart is essential for ministry. A servant's heart allows the person to put aside his or her own agenda in order to carry out Christ's mission. The best leader in the church is the one who is willing to serve.

Jesus taught this not only to James and John but to the other ten disciples who were there listening. Jesus also called the whole church to do the same. As the Church, we are all called to serve first, but often we fail to heed our true calling: servanthood.

Beware! The barriers to evangelism in congregations are apathy, lack of concern, no sense of urgency, "do not see it as our responsibility," the "what's in it for me?" attitude.

Based on a relationship with Jesus Christ, a true servant puts aside his or her own agenda in order to carry out Christ's mission.

The highest compliment a believer can give God is to invite a friend to know him.
