OCTOBER 27, 2024 GOSPEL

Reading of the Holy Gospel according to Saint Mark (10, 46-52)

As Jesus was leaving Jericho with his disciples and a sizable crowd, Bartimaeus, a blind man, the son of Timaeus, sat by the roadside begging. On hearing that it was Jesus of Nazareth, he began to cry out and say, "Jesus, son of David, have pity on me." And many rebuked him, telling him to be silent. But he kept calling out all the more, "Son of David, have pity on me."

Jesus stopped and said, "Call him." So they called the blind man, saying to him, "Take courage; get up, Jesus is calling you." He threw aside his cloak, sprang up, and came to Jesus. Jesus said to him in reply, "What do you want me to do for you?" The blind man replied to him, "Master, I want to see." Jesus told him, "Go your way; your faith has saved you." Immediately he received his sight and followed him on the way.

REFLECTION

The Gospel tells us the intimate encounter between Jesus and the blind beggar. The man's cry still reaches the compassionate heart of Jesus who stops and summons him. It becomes prayer where a human being seeks God, and God gives his full attention to the needy person.

This is precisely what happens every time we make the slightest move to connect with God. No amount of distraction around us and within us can block the encounter.

The story of Bartimaeus reminds us that being blind can be understood in both a literal and a metaphorical way. Physical blindness may be a disability but it is not a condition that is morally blameworthy.

Many maintain that narcissism, an excessive pre-occupation with oneself, is a growing sin of our times. Narcissism makes us blind to other people, to human need and to action for a better world. Narcissism is a form of spiritual blindness and a denial of reality. We can all engage in narcissistic behaviours to a greater or lesser extent. The Bartimaeus story, understood in its context, challenges our narcissistic tendencies and offers instead the example of Jesus, the Man for Others.
