

GOSPEL


Reading of the Holy Gospel according to Saint Luke (1:1-4; 4:14-21)

Since many have undertaken to compile a narrative of the events that have been fulfilled among us, just as those who were eyewitnesses from the beginning and ministers of the word have handed them down to us, I too have decided, after investigating everything accurately anew, to write it down in an orderly sequence for you, most excellent Theophilus, so that you may realize the certainty of the teachings you have received.

Jesus returned to Galilee in the power of the Spirit, and news of him spread throughout the whole region. He taught in their synagogues and was praised by all. He came to Nazareth, where he had grown up, and went according to his custom into the synagogue on the sabbath day. He stood up to read and was handed a scroll of the prophet Isaiah. He unrolled the scroll and found the passage where it was written: The Spirit of the Lord is upon me, because he has anointed me to bring glad tidings to the poor. He has sent me to proclaim liberty to captives and recovery of sight to the blind, to let the oppressed go free, and to proclaim a year acceptable to the Lord. Rolling up the scroll, he handed it back to the attendant and sat down.

REFLECTION

In the reading that Christ does in the synagogue, not only his coming is indicated, but even his mission, his plan of action, his road map, which is the same one that we, his followers, must follow. "He has sent me to announce the Gospel to the poor, to announce freedom to the captives, and sight to the blind. To give freedom to the oppressed; to announce the year of favor of the Lord."

Perhaps some of us can get hooked on "the year of the Lord's favor." We cannot take it literally. It is a way of saying the beginning of another time, another era, another period. From here onwards. Just as we actually count years in the West: before Christ and after Christ. It is that we have entered another period, another stage in the history of salvation. We are in the Year of Grace of the Lord. It is the Trinity itself acting in history, illuminating it to make our Salvation possible. That is what the Scriptures refer to. And this is what the Lord tells us that has been fulfilled.

This is the Good News. We have entered a new period of history. The doors of heaven have been opened; we have been liberated. The alliance has been restored. Jesus, our Redeemer, has made it possible. Driven by the Holy Spirit, He is the Bridge, He is the Way to the Father.

The Lord has come to be food for the poor, the oppressed, the blind, the afflicted, the persecuted. He is the haven of peace that we seek, the beginning of a new life, of a new history, that of the New Testament, that of the Year of the Lord's Grace. All of life itself is impregnated with that Grace. We are living new times. We can look forward with hope, because the pact has been sealed, with the Blood of Christ. Dying on the cross and rising from the dead, he opened the doors of heaven for us. The Camino is laid out and restored. Let us move through this year of grace, towards the arms of the Father, who has always been waiting for us to occupy the place he has reserved for us. What better news!
