

MARCH 16, 2025 GOSPEL

Reading of the Holy Gospel according to Saint Luke (9:28b-36)


Jesus took Peter, John, and James and went up the mountain to pray. While he was praying his face changed in appearance and his clothing became dazzling white. And behold, two men were conversing with him, Moses and Elijah, who appeared in glory and spoke of his exodus that he was going to accomplish in Jerusalem.

Peter and his companions had been overcome by sleep, but becoming fully awake, they saw his glory and the two men standing with him. As they were about to part from him, Peter said to Jesus, "Master, it is good that we are here; let us make three tents, one for you, one for Moses, and one for Elijah."

But he did not know what he was saying. While he was still speaking, a cloud came and cast a shadow over them, and they became frightened when they entered the cloud. Then from the cloud came a voice that said, "This is my chosen Son; listen to him." After the voice had spoken, Jesus was found alone.

They fell silent and did not at that time tell anyone what they had seen.

LORD'S WORD



MARCH 16, 2025

Sunday is the day of the Resurrection and the day God created everything in the universe, including human beings, who are in His image and likeness. In this context, the Transfiguration on Mount Tabor is extraordinarily special because it is an assurance that the firstfruits of God's new creation will be the resurrected humanity of Christ.

Moses symbolized the Law and the Covenant, while Elijah symbolized the Prophets. Moses and Elijah reassure Jesus that He must fulfill the law and prophecy. Jesus needed this assurance because He was a man like us in every way except sin.

When we obey God's Law and Covenant and listen to the Prophets He sends us, we experience glimpses of God's majesty, often seen or revealed in transfigurative moments of our daily lives, such as the halo after a retreat or a good and authentic confession (Sacrament of Reconciliation); a "Strange" moment upon seeing something of exquisite beauty in nature; the gentle touch of a compassionate and loving hand in a moment of great pain and sadness; or even the ecstasy of love. In such moments, our faces are illuminated by the encounter with the Divine.

Transfiguration is a uniquely personal experience, when we are touched by the Divine Presence and profoundly changed. It is a transformative and liberating moment for those who experience it. Intimacy with God, justice for God's people, and love for humanity can prepare the ground for these divine encounters.
